PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO WALSINGHAM October 22nd – 24th,

I have been in touch with Elmham House, which will provide our accommodation, and I have reserved rooms for two nights, Tuesday 22nd and Wednesday 23rd October. I have purposely gone for dates during

autumn half term. Arrival mid pm 22nd. Leave after breakfast 24th.

30 beds have been booked, including 6 first floor twin ensuite rooms. The rest are a mix of singles/twins. We may be joined by some from St. Catharine's Chipping Campden. In due course I will provide an itinerary, which will include visits to the Anglican and Orthodox shrines, as well as our own; time for the Sacraments, of course, opportunity to walk the Holy Mile and free time/optional visit to the sea. We will have a celebratory dinner on the second evening. Deposit £20 pp. A list will go up when I am back.

Starts on Wednesday 6th March. As previously advertised there will be just one **Ash Wednesday Mass:** 6 pm Stow with blessing of Ashes, hymns.

At **6 pm in Stow** on Fridays in Lent, starting on Friday 8th March, we will alternate between **Stations of the Cross**, (March 8,22, April 5th) and **ADORATION OF THE BLESSED EUCHARIST** (March 15, 29, April 12). Adoration will be a time of complete silence in front of the exposed Blessed Sacrament, lasting from 6 pm- 7 pm during which people can come and go as they wish.
