Dear Parish Priests of the Diocese

I hope you're all keeping safe & well at this time.

Please could I ask for your help relating to two different important educational matters at the start of the new school year. These are;

1 – As usual, we want to try to ensure that parents of Catholic children who are due to start school, apply for a place at the right time. Every year some parents unfortunately miss the closing date or forget to provide their child's baptism certificate and so may miss out on a place at a Catholic school.

Please would you therefore kindly help parents, by including the following notice in all your newsletters from 1 September 2020 to 10 January 2021:

Starting School? If you have a child born between 1 September 2016 and 31 August 2017, then now is the time to apply for a place at a primary school for admission from September 2021 onwards. You must complete an application form that is available from the school admissions team of the [INSERT NAME OF YOUR LOCAL COUNCIL(S)] Council. If your child has been baptised and you are applying for a Catholic school, you must also provide a copy of the baptism certificate to the school. Please ensure you apply by the closing date of 15 January 2021.

Please remember to delete the text in red font above, and to insert the name(s) of the Council(s) that covers your parish(es). Select from Bath & North East Somerset, Bristol, Gloucestershire, North Somerset, Somerset, South Gloucestershire, Swindon and Wiltshire, as appropriate.

2 – As I'm sure you're aware, there are many schools in the Diocese who are operating without their full quota of Foundation Governors. To help address this, we would be very grateful if could also include the following notice in all your newsletters throughout **September**, even if any school in your parish(es) does not currently have any vacancies.

Could you be a School Governor? The Diocese is seeking to recruit people to serve on school governing bodies. If you believe in Catholic education, have enthusiasm and commitment, then you can make a valuable contribution to the governing body of a Catholic school.
