NEWS/NOTICES. **St. Lawrence's Church, Bourton.**

Thanks to the hospitality of The Rector of Bourton-on-the-Water, The Rev'd Rowena King and her PCC, Mass is now said at 9 am every Tuesday at St Lawrence's Anglican Church, Bourton. We are extremely grateful for this privilege. The photos on this newsheet are of the first occasion – Tuesday 17th August, 2021. (18 people attended). We use the Chancel, which was built in 1328, financed by a benefactor Walter de Burhton. The 14th century Chancel replaced an earlier Norman building (possibly earlier). In the photo below you



can see the servers are sitting on a sedilia where clergy and servers will have sat before The Reformation. We use the piscina and the shelf above for the cruets (water and wine) as will always have been the case. The interior of St. Lawrence's was beautifully refurbished and re-ordered in 2017 and we are very fortunate to be able to be guests in the Church. I encourage parishioners (of any denomination) to come to a Tuesday Mass here. Parking is in the field at the top of School Hill. (Coming from Bourton High Street, turn right by the Mobility Centre). A very short walk takes you to the West door of the Church. **First Communion candidates.** On Sunday 26th September, four individuals will make their First Communion at the 9 am Mass: Mar su Dunn, Althea and Raymark Antiojo and Maggie Barrow. Due to the pandemic and other constraints, getting everyone together for the sessions has been a logistical nightmare this year. I would like to thank Jane Cannon, who has taught them, for her hard work and persistence in bringing this year's sessions to a successful conclusion and all the parents for their part. I have several names for next year's First Communion course. Please get

in touch with me if you are interested in this or the Sacrament of Confirmation. **Sunday of the Racehorse.** Our parishioner Richard Phillips, racehorse trainer in Adlestrop, is the initiator of National Racehorse Week 12-19th September.
